After graduating from Capital University Law School in 2003, Amanda was with the Office of the Ohio Public Defender until 2016. While there, she supervised attorneys in the youth appeals section and litigated more than 120 appeals, including eight cases argued in the Supreme Court of Ohio, for children with delinquency adjudications or those transferred to adult court. As a consultant, Amanda has assisted with litigation strategies for youth in jurisdictions across the country, including authoring and coauthoring The Gault Center's amicus briefs in the Supreme Courts of Missouri and Ohio, and their assessments in Arizona and Oregon. Amanda works as a contract legal researcher for Colorado's Office of Alternate Defense Counsel where she focuses on creative litigation strategies and teeing up issues for appeal. Amanda has been a proud certified trainer for The Gault Center's Youth Defender Advocacy Program (formerly JTIP) since 2014 and has trained youth defenders in nearly 1000 training sessions across 30 states and the District of Columbia.
