

Megan Leschak, LMSW is an investigator in the Capital Habeas Unit at the Federal Public Defender in Los Angeles. Prior to her current position, she was in private practice as co-owner of Context Mitigation. Megan began her mitigation and forensic social work career at the Maryland Office of the Public Defender where she was awarded a Soros Fellowship to highlight for the courts the impact of structural racism, poverty, and violence on Baltimore City defendants. She subsequently worked as an investigator for the Delaware Federal Public Defender and as the social work supervisor for the New Mexico Law Offices of the Public Defender. Megan earned her MSW from the University of Maryland where she co-created the course *Racism and Racial Equity in Social Work Practice*. She has trained defense professionals at conferences across the country.
